

# Creation Research UK Field Trip Information, Terms & Conditions, and Legal Disclaimer

Thank you for joining us on this Creation Research UK field trip. We hope it will provide you with plenty of thought-provoking material! Please ensure you have received three documents after you have booked: This general information document, your handbook for the day (which includes timings and parking information), and your confirmation of booking email. Please bring your confirmation email on the day, either printed out or on your phone.

## About the Trip

There are several different kinds of field trips we lead. The most common one is fossil finding trips, but we also do geology & process, natural history, and archaeology field trips as well. The nature of the field trip will be specified on advert, and the booking information, as well as your ticket. The general layout of the trip will include an introduction and health & safety, several stops throughout the trip to explain geology, an explanation of fossils/geology/biology, and how to find them, and a conclusion. **Please note:** Every field trip is different. There may be breaks for lunch, depending on the timing, and may go on for longer, depending on the interest. All details of the field trip you are attending can be found in your handbook.

## Health & Safety

A risk assessment for each location will be provided on the day. If you would like to receive a copy, please contact the organisers at least **two days beforehand**, to receive one. The risk assessment will include possible hazards on the field trip. These may include, but not be limited to: trip hazards (rocks, stumps, etc.), cliff fall, tides & water dangers, tool usage (hammers, etc.), hazardous objects (broken glass, etc.), and weather conditions. A health and safety announcement will be made, and the risk assessment shown at the beginning of the field trip, but Creation Research UK takes no responsibility for individuals (see legal disclaimer below).

Please wear appropriate clothing for the occasion. Most locations require sturdy boots or wellies, and potentially waterproof trousers, coat, hat, and gloves, depending on weather conditions.

Tools may be useful if you have them, but are not necessary. Generally speaking, only the fossil-finding trips require any tools, and the leaders will always carry them. Most fossils can be found on the beach, without any tools, so they are not a strict requirement. Please be aware that any tools brought are the responsibility of the person bringing them.

Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Creation Research UK, and the leaders of the field trip cannot be responsible for the care and safety of children on the trip.

## Legal Disclaimer

Creation Research UK exists to distribute knowledge and perform research that upholds the Bible as the Word of God. It does this through teachings, research trips, debates, and field trips.

While on a field trip, Creation Research UK will attempt to make it as safe an environment as possible for those attending, by:
